




MANCHESTER AT A GLANCE



In 2022, Manchester's tech startups contributed 1.7% to the £1.2bn worth of funding raised by the UK's tech startups. Playing a critical role in the UK's early growth stats, our Greater Manchester entrants make up 13% of the estimated 190 tech businesses (less than a year old) that have successfully attracted investment.




